

## **John Johnson Collection Adds Chatham House Donation: WWII**

This section has not been catalogued or digitised.

**Note:** John Johnson established 1939 as the cut-off date for his Collection, specifically excluding WWII ephemera on the grounds that "War-time A.R.P. ephemera alone would fill room-space many times the whole existing space of the Sanctuary." This donation from Royal Institute of International Affairs (Chatham House) has, in part, filled the gap.

Additionally, the John Fraser Collection contains substantial numbers of WWII postcards.
